Finances

We are excited to announce that, in recognition of the excellent work done by the former Budget and Reserve Committee, we will be formalizing a new Finance Subcommittee. Central Recreation

Last year we surveyed homeowners and began development of plans supporting the refresh of the central rec / tennis court area. These concepts included reconfiguration of the multi-use space to include pickleball courts, updating of the surface, and refreshing equipment.

This year we continued the due diligence around the surface condition, a key driver to the project budget, by pulling up tiles on the existing sport court to better assess the condition of the underlying asphalt. From doing this we understood there to be large cracks from roots, low spots previously patched and filled in, and in general a surface needing more than a simple overlay of new asphalt.

Many thanks to those who helped with this effort as part of the Spring Cleanup as it has enabled us to receive more precise bids for the surface update options. See below for pictures from the day the tiles were pulled up and some of the surface issues investigated.



Most recently we have been investigating financial options for the project including financing options similar to what was done with the pier dock when it was put in.

Dock & Marina

Our 2025 boating season is off to a fantastic start! Our much needed weed treatment was completed successfully in early June and our next treatment will occur sometime this week. We continue to investigate options for weed removal, algae, and swimmer's itch treatments with proper DNR permits. Did you know that Bald Eagle Lake was officially removed from Minnesota's impaired waters list in October 2024, marking the success of years of hard work to improve the lake's water quality!

Here are a few reminders of our Dock/Marina rules:

- The dock is for the use of West Oaks Association homeowners, their families, and their guests ONLY. All guests must be accompanied by a West Oaks Resident or an immediate family member while accessing the dock.
- Please remember that the area around the dock is a NO WAKE ZONE.

Spring Clean Up/Beautification Day -

Many thanks to everyone for the amazing work during our Spring Clean Up and Beautification Day! We accomplished so much together and it was a great opportunity to catch up with each other too. The winter reinforcing beams on the dock were taken down, the fence was put in, the marina sign was moved and reinforced, flowers and plants were added near our main West Oaks sign, and we were able to get a good look at the base surface of the sports court. Thank you for your efforts to brighten up our neighborhood!
