#### **Finances**

Over the course of the past 12+ months – the Budget and Reserve Committee have worked diligently to provide a recommendation to the Board of Directors to create a process for estimating the future financial reserve requirements for the replacement and maintenance of our common assets (e.g., tennis courts, marina, dock, street and community signs, etc.).

The Committee's scope has been to offer recommendations for the Board's consideration. Their contributions have been valuable in supporting the Board's efforts. Some of their key accomplishments include:

- Compiling a comprehensive list of all WOHA assets
- Estimating initial costs and lifespan of each asset
- Developing a spreadsheet to calculate future replacement costs
- Determining approximate reserve requirements
- Incorporating these findings into the annual WOHA budget
- Offering recommendations regarding asset maintenance, dues increases, and assessments

The Committee's work has given us a clearer picture of our current financial situation. While we now have a robust understanding of our reserves and future needs, it's clear that additional funding will be required to address future asset replacements, and the board is actively working through this now.

Your efforts are greatly appreciated, and we are thankful for your commitment to ensuring the long-term stability of our community.

#### **Central Recreation**

During the spring clean-up, we are planning to partially pull up the sport court surface to better inspect the asphalt underneath. The quality of this asphalt will be a key component of the potential cost of renovations to this area.

The surveys completed in 2024 found:

- 72% of WOHA Members said they would use the space more frequently if it were designed differently or had different amenities.
- The top priorities of WOHA members for the space were:
  - 1. Pickleball
  - 2. Playground
  - 3. Tennis
  - 4. Basketball
  - 5. Pavilion
- 86% of WOHA Members were supportive of using loan financing as part of a funding approach.

We are estimating that the repairs and redesign of the space will cost between \$150,000-\$250,000 (\$2,542 to \$4,237 per household). Variables include the severity of the repairs needed to the underlying asphalt, amenity additions, degree of layout change, and other factors.

Your input in the 2024 surveys, concept reviews and discussion at the Annual Night to Unite and Annual Meeting have been essential, along with the roundtable discussion held in March.

Once we know the state of the underlying asphalt, and its cost, the Board of Directors will communicate this cost with the proposed next steps.

#### **Lawn Care**

We will be using professional lawn care this upcoming summer. We have included the Marina area so that the brush can be trimmed back near the walkway and parking area. Service will include mowing, weed treatment and fertilizing, trimming of shrubs and plantings, and blowing leaves and debris off the courts regularly. A cleanup of leaves is also planned as part of the service in the fall and spring making our annual West Oaks Spring Cleanup event more manageable for volunteers.
